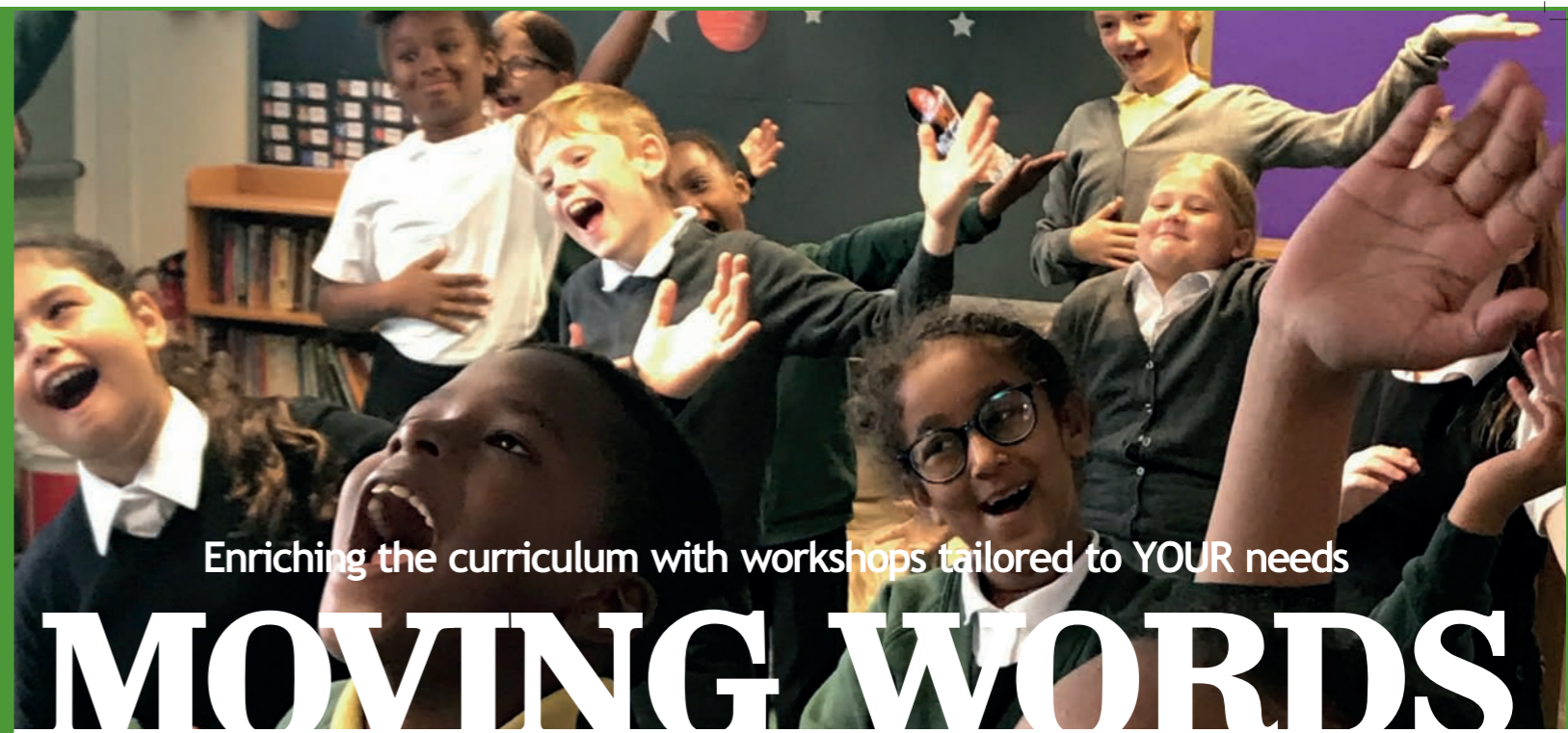


**WHAT TO DO NEXT:**
